Smeal College of Business and Donald P. Bellisario College of Communications

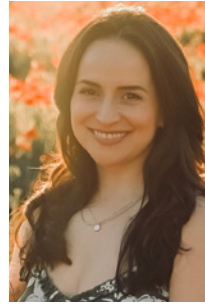
