- Stressed importance of conduct as a prelude to professional life.
- Leads by example and explanation - strikes a good balance between visual and verbal communication.
- Stacy shows great versatility by referencing a number of dance ORGANIZATION styles with knowledge and experience.
- Connected the experience of this class to other dance classes and encouraged students to integrate those experiences.
- By way of more than one example, Stacy helped the students understand that dance steps are defined by style and context - specifically, how that concept is communicated through posture and attitude.
- She was careful to discuss the "how" of good technique.
- During class, she was willing to break down the choreography and explain it with attention to physical detail. She was very good about making rounds and addressing each couple individually.
