Prior to joining Hitachi Vantara, Gajen spent 15 years with Cognizant, most recently as President of the company's \$4B digital business, a role in which he led the acquisitions of Softvision, Netcentric, and Idea Couture. He drove a Cognizant-wide initiative to transform company capabilities and services into an integrated, industry- and customer-focused suite of offerings and solutions. During his time at Cognizant, he also built and led multiple businesses in different phases of growth and change – from start ups and emerging businesses to turnarounds and hypergrowth companies.

Prior to joining Cognizant, he co-founded NerveWire, Inc., a venture capital-backed management consulting and systems integration firm, which was later acquired by Wipro.
