### I. MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

- **EIGHT upper-division courses with at least TWO from each topic area:**  
*-Topic area courses must be at least four units each and may only count in one topic area.*

*-If Public Health 139 and 159 are taken more than once, topic must be different than one counting for upper-division core above.*

### C. PRACTICUM REQUIREMENT

- Public Health 195W (8 units), fulfills upper-division writing General Education requirement. A grade of at least a “C” or higher is required to pass the Practicum requirement/upper-division writing requirement.

### II. UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

- 180 quarter units are required for the B.A. degree. Students may need to take elective units to meet the 180 UCI unit requirements.
- In addition to the above requirements, UCI Entry Level Writing, American History & American Institutions, and General Education/Breadth requirements must be completed to be awarded a B.A. in Public Health Policy.
- Freshman students complete degree in 12 full-time quarters; Transfer students in 9 full-time quarters (not including Summer Sessions).
- **All courses taken to fulfill major requirements must be taken for a letter grade.**
