C. <u>PRACTICUM REQUIREMENT</u>

Public Health 195W (8 units), fulfills upper-division writing General Education requirement. A grade of at least a "C" or higher is required to pass the Practicum requirement/upper-division writing requirement.

II. UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

- 180 quarter units are required for the B.A. degree. Students may need to take elective units to meet the 180 UCI unit requirements.
- In addition to the above requirements, UCI Entry Level Writing, American History & American Institutions, and General Education/Breadth requirements must be completed to be awarded a B.A. in Public Health Policy.
- Freshman students complete degree in <u>12 full-time quarters</u>; Transfer students in <u>9 full-time quarters</u> (not including Summer Sessions).
