The acceptance rate for CSCW 2019 was 31.1%, the acceptance rate for CHI 2020 was 25.7%, the acceptance rate for CHI 2023 was 28.4%. Pervasive Health did not publish acceptance rates in 2015 or 2022 but noted it averaged below 30% in preceding years, the published acceptance rate in 2018 was 24%.
