## **University of Portland Grand Challenges Scholars Program**

**Program Elements:** The GCSP at UP requires that each student completes five components designed to prepare him/her to successfully contribute solutions to the Grand Challenges. Components designated at the expertise level include a direct connection to a Grand Challenge that helps the student to develop higher order competencies of application, analysis, evaluation, and/or creation. Components designated at the exposure level provide students with the breadth needed to understand Grand Challenges. The basic structure for the proposed program is outlined below.

- 1. Creative Learning Experience (Expertise Level Only)
- 2. Interdisciplinary Experience (Exposure Level Only)
- 3. Entrepreneurship and Innovation Experience (Exposure and Expertise Levels)\*
- 4. Global and Cross-Cultural Perspectives (Exposure and Expertise Levels)\*
- 5. **Social Consciousness Through Service-Learning** (Exposure Level Only)
- \* Either component 3 or 4 must be completed at the expertise level
