This form is provided to inform students about the academic milestones that they will be expected to reach to earn their PhD degree, as well as when they are expected to complete these milestones. Students are expected to reach each milestone within the specified time period in order to make satisfactory progress through the program. Students who are not making satisfactory progress may lose funding, be placed on academic probation, or be dismissed from the program. This form must be completed annually and submitted to the Sustainable Earth Systems Sciences (SESS) Department Office.

Academic Advising:

The PhD research supervisor will serve as advisor for the purposes below.

- The advisor will provide the student with guidance and mentoring and will seek the assistance of other faculty and graduate school resources when necessary to support the student's academic and career development.
- The advisor will ensure that a mutually agreed upon set of expectations and goals for the

student is in place and assessed periodically.

- The advisor will help the student assemble a thesis/dissertation committee.
- The advisor will provide career advice and links to information on previous graduate placement.
- The advisor will be accessible to give advice and feedback on career goals.

Academic advising includes the following elements that are designed to ensure that students remain in good academic standing and make satisfactory progress through the program:

- Reviews between student and advisor will be conducted annually. The results of this review will be included in the program's annual doctoral progress report.
- Suggestions on course selection
- Review of Degree Plan to determine if modifications are necessary
- Clarification of the timetable for completing any remaining course requirements, examinations, and other requirements
- Assistance in understanding the requirements for successful completion of dissertation

Degree Completion Checklist for Students:
