# Move-In Details

## **Move-In Date and Time**

It is important that you arrive at your assigned time to help ensure a smooth check-in process. Residents were sent their move-in letters via UTD email on July 22. Those emails included their move-in date and assigned time.

When you arrive on campus, you will check-in at the Visitor's Center prior to arriving at your building. You will need to bring your Comet Card (or a government-issued photo ID) in order to pick up your keys. Keys will only be released to the resident.

## **Items Not to Bring**

The following items are prohibited:

 Candles, incense, extension cords, power strips link to power strips ("daisy-chaining"), halogen light bulbs, and any items with an open heating source, such as hot plates and heaters

- Command strips and other adhesive materials are not allowed for decorating, but thumbtacks, small picture nails, or small screws are permissible for hanging items
- Handguns, firearms, or weapons of any type, as well as any explosive, flammable, or hazardous substances, or any items of a dangerous nature
