# 2026 Systems Science for Social Impact

Summer Training Institute at the WashU School of Public Health

At this 5-day Summer Training Institute, participants will get a hands-on introduction to systems science methods that enhance the social impact of health and social science research. Led by experienced systems science scholars, this in-depth training institute will feature five major systems science tracks: **intro to systems, agent-based modeling, group model building, social network analysis**, and **system dynamics**. Participants will review the major concepts of their chosen track, learn analytic best practices, and apply the methods to real-world data.
