



DOCTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY ADMISSIONS PLANNING WORKSHEET

MINIMUM UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age to matriculate is 18 years of age.
- Applicants must be a US Citizen, permanent resident or with DACA status.
- Applicant must have earned a baccalaureate, masters, or doctorate degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- Satisfactory completion of the following college courses, which may include laboratory work, before matriculation:
 - These basic requirements must be passed (C or above recommended) and taken for credit at a regionally accredited college or university. Advanced placement credits can fulfill the course requirements if they were accepted for credit by your degree granting institution.
 - Students must receive a passing grade on the first attempt in at least 6 of the prerequisite courses and pass any repeat on the first attempt. Coursework older than 7 years old is not accepted.

Human Anatomy with lab: 4 semester hours/ 6 quarter hours (do not recommend online or hybrid courses for lab)

Human Physiology: 4 semester hours / 6 quarter hours (do not recommend online or hybrid courses for lab)

Biological Sciences (not botany): 8 semester hours/12 quarter hours, recommend upper division course in genetics.

Chemistry (General or Inorganic, Organic or Biochemistry) all with labs: 8 semester hours / 12 quarter hours (do not recommend online or hybrid courses for lab)

Physics with lab including mechanics, heat, light, sound, and electricity: 8 semester hours / 12 quarter hours (do not recommend online or hybrid courses for lab)

Psychology: 3 semester hours / 5 quarter hours; abnormal psychology or psychological aspects of disabilities preferred

Statistics: 3 semester hours / 5 quarter hours

Doctor of Physical Therapy program applicants are considered on their intellectual ability, scholastic achievement, commitment, and suitability to succeed in the study of physical therapy.
